## What is the “Fast Track to Hire” Event?

- TSA Boston (BOS) is now hiring both full-time & part-time Transportation Security Officers (TSOs) starting at **\$19.00/hr**
- This event will provide you an opportunity to accelerate the TSO hiring process
- No experience is required

If you successfully complete the candidate evaluation process and are selected for a TSO position, you will play a vital role in supporting the TSA and Department of Homeland Security (DHS) mission.

## What Should I Expect?

This event will feature multiple hiring process steps in one day. Provided you pass each hiring process component, your day could consist of:

- Attending an **Information Session** to learn more about the TSO position and employment with TSA;
- **Applying** for the TSO position, if you did not apply online prior to the event;
- Taking a **Computer Based Test** to evaluate English language proficiency and x-ray interpretation aptitude;
- The candidate evaluation process may take up to four hours. Consider arriving to the event early to allow more time to complete the full process.

## Tips for the Event

- Apply online in advance of the event for quicker processing
- Arrive 15 minutes before any scheduled session to check-in
- For on-site application, candidates are encouraged to bring a cell phone and have access to a valid personal email account.
- Bring two valid forms of state or federal issued identification\*

\* **Forms of Identification:** *Upon arrival to the facility, you will be required to present two forms of identification (i.e., passport, driver’s license, birth certificate, etc.; photocopies not accepted). At least one form of identification must bear both a photograph and a signature. You will not be admitted to the test without these two pieces of identification. Both forms of identification must be legible, unexpired and issued with your full legal name, which must match the name on your TSA job application.*

## How to get to the Event

The TSA Fast Track to Hire Event will be held at the Embassy Suites Boston at Logan Airport, 207 Porter Street, Boston, MA 02128. (Please see driving directions below).

**Directions:** Public Transportation is available and the BLUE MBTA Airport Station is near the event location. When you arrive at the station, you will then take the airport Blue shuttle #22 or #33 to Rental Car facility and walk to hotel. Refer to [www.mbta.com](http://www.mbta.com) for transit schedules, directions and routes.

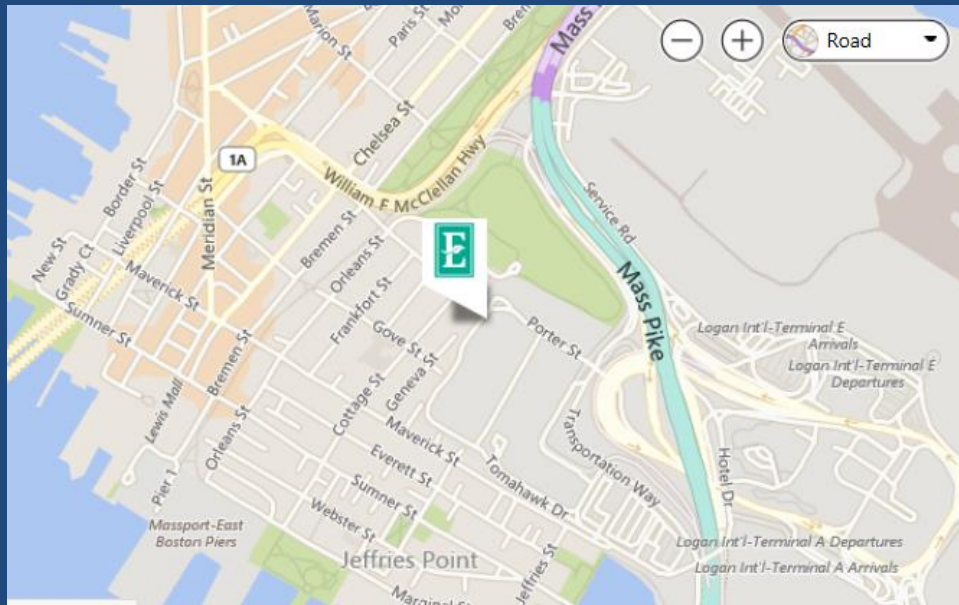


If you are driving, valet parking is available at the hotel for **\$15.00 (for the day)**. Parking will not be validated or reimbursed; candidates should be prepared to pay. Hotel does not have a self-parking lot for public use.

**Event Check-In:** Registration / Check-In for the event is located in the hotel atrium area in the lobby of the hotel.

**Please do not bring the following items to the event:** firearms, knives, or weapons of any kind. Possession of such items will result in dismissal from the facility. We also ask that you do not have anyone accompany you as non-applicants will not be permitted in the testing area.

## Driving Directions:



\*\*\*When using a GPS for hotel directions, it is suggested that you enter "Boston Logan Airport" into the GPS and follow signs to the Embassy Suites. If you enter the hotel address into the GPS, it will bring you to an entrance you cannot enter.\*\*\*

**From the North Shore:** Take Route 1 South to Route 60 East to Route 1A south. Follow the signs to Logan Airport and then Follow Signs that say Hotel & Car Rentals pass straight through the set of lights. Take your first right and the hotel will be on your Left.

**From Northern Massachusetts:** Merge onto I-93 S toward BOSTON. Take the RT-1A exit, EXIT 24B-A, toward AIRPORT/GOV'T CTR. Take the RT-1A N exit, EXIT 24-B, on the LEFT toward AIRPORT. Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto MA-1A N/WILLIAM F MCCLELLAN HWY/EAST BOSTON EXPY. Take the LOGAN AIRPORT ramp. Stay STRAIGHT to go onto PORTER ST. Follow Signs that say Hotel & Car Rentals pass straight through the set of lights. Take your first right and the hotel will be on your Left.

### **From Western Massachusetts:**

Merge onto I-90 E/MASS PIKE/MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE via EXIT 7 toward MASS PIKE EAST/WORCESTER/BOSTON (Portions toll). Take EXIT 26 toward LOGAN AIRPORT. Turn RIGHT onto HOTEL DR. Turn RIGHT onto HARBORSIDE DR. Turn LEFT onto PORTER ST. Hotel will be on the right.

**From South Shore/Cape Cod:** Follow Route 3 North to I-93 North to Route 90 East (exit 20). Follow Route 90 East through the Ted Williams Tunnel. As you exit the tunnel, bear right toward Hotel Drive. Follow Hotel Drive to your second set of lights and take a right onto Harborside Drive. Follow Harborside Drive to the second set of lights and turn left onto Porter Street. The hotel will be on your right.

**From Boston :** Merge onto I-93 N/US-1 N/MA-3 N/SOUTHEAST EXPY toward BOSTON. Take EXIT 26 toward LOGAN AIRPORT. Turn RIGHT onto HOTEL DR. Turn RIGHT onto HARBORSIDE DR to the second set of lights and turn left onto Porter Street. The hotel will be on your right.

We are excited that you are considering employment with TSA. The TSO position is a great way to start a career with the Federal government. From the TSO position, the opportunities are endless. Many Officers opt to follow a career path within TSA while others eventually transfer to other DHS components (such as Customs & Border Protection, Immigration and Customs Enforcement, etc.) or other federal agencies during their career.

Federal employees working full-time or part-time are eligible for Federal benefits and retirement once eligibility requirements are met. These benefits include, but are not limited to health insurance, dental insurance, life insurance, flexible health care spending accounts, federal retirement benefits and many more. Health insurance is offered through the Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) program. The health benefit program has many plans to choose from and all at group rates, which can be paid for with pre-tax income.
