What is the “Fast Track to Hire” Event?

- TSA Columbia (COU) is now hiring part-time Transportation Security Officers (TSOs) starting at **\$17.19/hr.**
- This event will provide you an opportunity to accelerate the TSO hiring process
- No experience is required
- Consider arriving early to allow more time to complete all components

Minimum Qualifications

- 18 years or older
- US Citizen or National
- High school diploma, GED, or security experience equivalent

What Should I Expect?

This event will feature multiple hiring components in one day. Provided you pass each component, your day could consist of:

- Attending an **Information Forum** to learn more about the TSO position and employment with TSA;
- **Applying** for the TSO position, if you did not apply on-line prior to the event;
- Taking a **Computer Based Test** to evaluate English language proficiency and x-ray interpretation aptitude;
- Participating in a **Structured Interview** to assess qualifications for the position.

Tips for the Event

- Free parking is available at the hotel
- Apply online in advance for quicker processing: <https://tsajobs.tsa.dhs.gov>
- Please bring your smartphone and passwords to access your email or USAJobs account
- Consider bringing a beverage, lunch or a snack
- Bring two valid forms of state or federal issued identification*

** Forms of Identification: Upon arrival to the facility, you will be required to present two forms of identification. At least one form of identification must bear both a photograph and a signature. You will not be admitted to the test without these two pieces of identification. Both forms of identification must be legible, unexpired and issued with your full legal name, which must match the name on your TSA job application.*

Please do not bring the following items to the event: firearms, knives, or weapons of any kind. Possession of such items will result in dismissal from the facility.

How to get to the Event

The TSA Fast Track to Hire Event will be held at the Marriott St. Louis West Hotel, 660 Maryville Centre Drive, St. Louis, MO 63141. Free parking is available at the hotel.

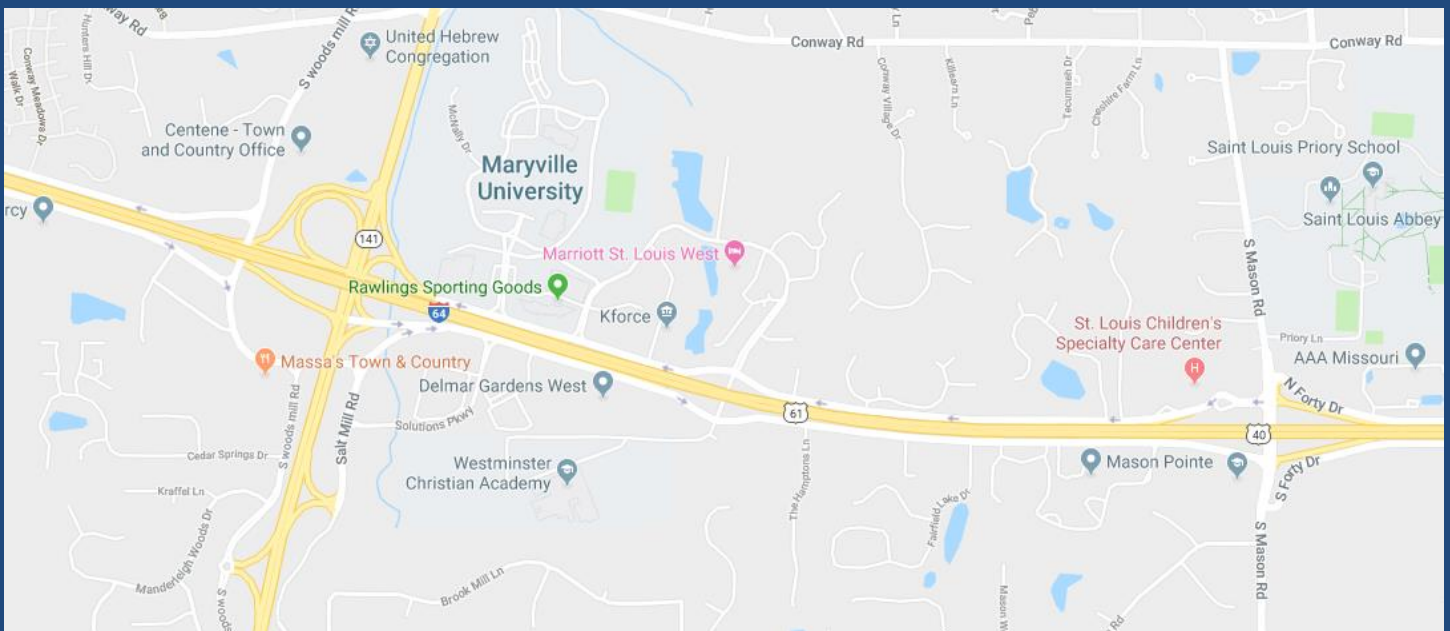
Driving Directions:

From Far West (Columbia): Go east on I-70/US-40. Take exit #210A to merge onto I-64/US-40/US-61S toward Chesterfield. Take Exit #22 Hwy 141/Woods Mill Rd. Go through the stoplight and follow the signs to S. Outer 40 to stoplight at Maryville Centre Drive. Make a left go through traffic light and hotel is on the left.

From North (Chicago): Take I-55 South to I-270 West. Go west on I-270 for approximately 40 miles to I-64/US-40 West (to Wentzville). Go west on I-64/US-40 for approximately 3 miles to Exit #23 Maryville Center Drive (2 exits west of I-270), make right onto Maryville Centre Drive and hotel is on left.

From South (Memphis): Take I-55 North to I-270 North. Go approximately 15 miles on I-270 to I-64/US-40 West (to Wentzville). Go west on I-64/US-40 for approximately 3 miles to Exit #23 make a right at the stoplight onto Maryville Centre Drive and hotel is on the left.

From East (Illinois/Indiana): Take I-44 West 15 miles, to I-270 North 5 miles, to I-64/US-40 West 2 miles. Take Exit #23 Maryville Centre Dr. Make right at the stoplight onto Maryville Centre Drive and hotel is on the left.



Once at the hotel, follow the TSA Fast Track to Hire signs to the event registration.

We are excited that you are considering employment with TSA. The TSO position is a great way to start a career with the Federal Government. From the TSO position, the opportunities are endless. Many Officers opt to follow a career path within TSA while others eventually transfer to other DHS agencies (such as Customs & Border Protection, Immigration and Customs Enforcement, etc.) or other federal agencies during their career.

Federal employees working full-time or part-time are eligible for federal benefits and retirement once eligibility requirements are met. These benefits include, but are not limited to health insurance, dental insurance, life insurance, flexible health care spending accounts, federal retirement benefits and many more. Health insurance is offered through the Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) program. The health benefit program has many plans to choose from and all at group rates, which can be paid for with pre-tax income.
