What is the “Fast Track to Hire” Event?

- TSA Portland (PDX) is now hiring both full-time and part-time Transportation Security Officers (TSOs), starting at **\$16.91 per hour**.
- This event will provide you an opportunity to accelerate the TSO hiring process.
- No security experience is required.
- Consider arriving early to allow more time to complete all components.

Minimum Qualifications

- 18 years or older.
- U.S. citizen or national.
- High school diploma, GED or security experience equivalent.

What Should I Expect?

This event will feature multiple hiring components in one day. Provided you pass each component, your day could consist of:

- Attending an information session to learn more about the TSO position and employment with TSA;
- Applying for the TSO position, if you did not apply on-line prior to the event;
- Taking a computer-based test (CBT) to evaluate English language proficiency and object recognition aptitude;
- Participating in a structured interview to assess qualifications for the position;
- Completing a medical evaluation, federal drug screening and pre-hire background investigation soon after the event.

Tips for the Event

- [Apply online in advance for quicker processing](#). Please note that a resume and previous work experience are not required for your USAJOBS profile nor the TSA application.
- Please bring your smartphone and/or passwords to access your email and USAJOBS account.
- Complimentary parking available at the Sheraton Portland Airport Hotel.
- Consider bringing a beverage, lunch or a snack.
- Bring two valid forms of federal or government-issued identification. *

*** Forms of Identification:** *You will be required to present two forms of identification. At least one form of identification must bear both a photograph and a signature. You will not be admitted to the computer-based test (CBT) without these two pieces of identification. Both forms of identification must be legible, unexpired and issued with your full legal name, which must match the name on your TSA job application.*

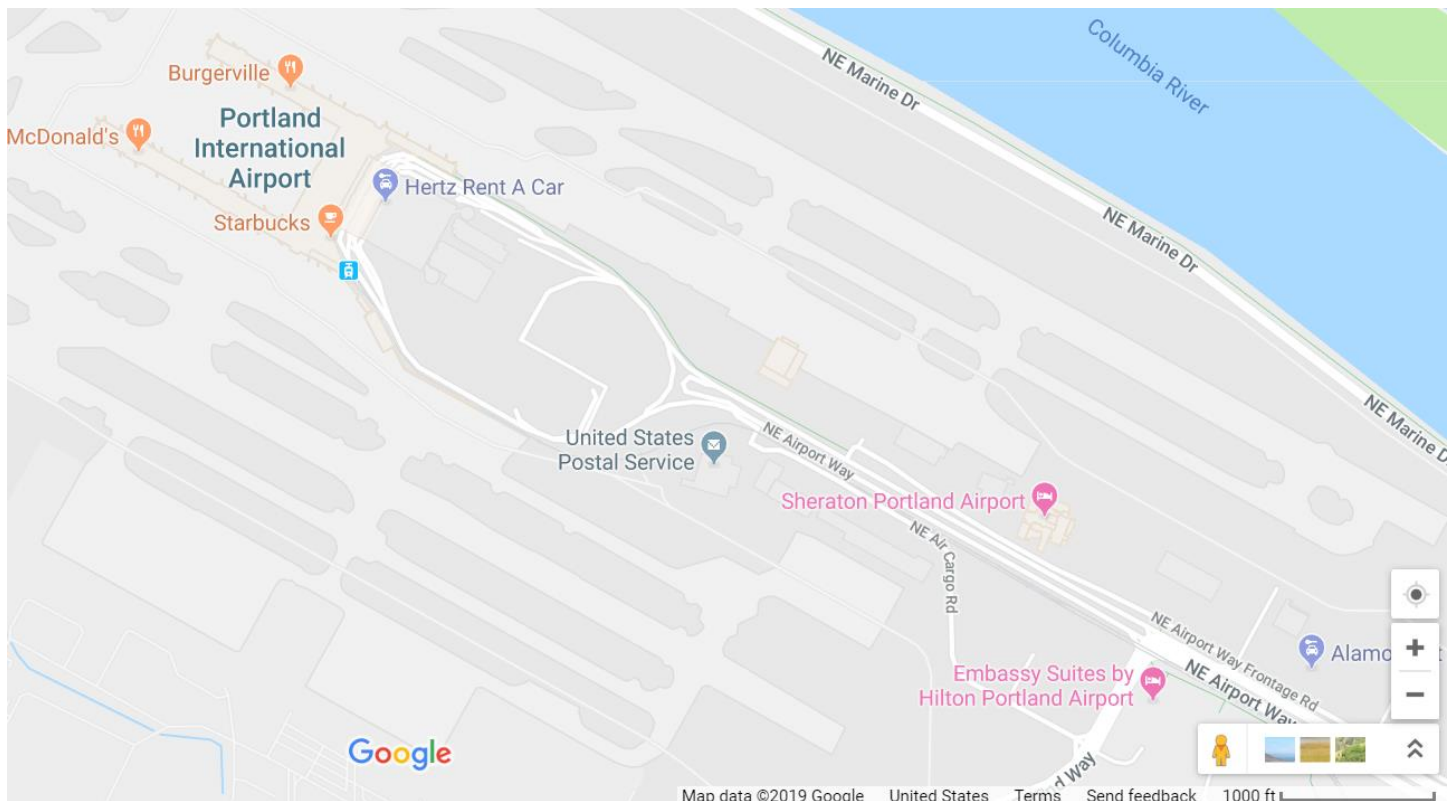

We are excited that you are considering employment with TSA. The TSO position is a great way to start a career with the Federal Government. From the TSO position, the opportunities are endless. Many Officers opt to follow a career path within TSA while others eventually transfer to other DHS agencies (such as Customs and Border Protection, Immigration and Customs Enforcement, etc.) or other federal positions during their career.

Federal employees working full-time or part-time are eligible for federal benefits and retirement once eligibility requirements are met. These benefits include, but are not limited to health insurance, dental insurance, life insurance, flexible health care spending accounts, federal retirement benefits and many more. Health insurance is offered through the Federal Employees Health Benefits (FEHB) program. The health benefit program has many plans to choose from and all at group rates, which can be paid for with pre-tax income.
